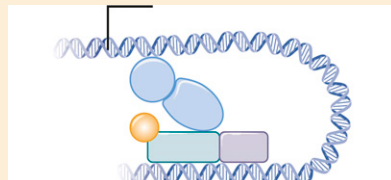

Glucagon, GLP-1, and GIP Activities



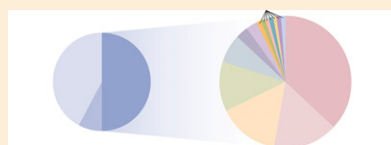
Steroidogenic Cell Development
